Happy Autumn, RPGA Parents and Athletes! As gymnastics instructors, we don't wish gymnasts a happy "fall" ;). We hope everyone is adjusting to their new school year schedules and enjoying their classes so far. We want to inform you of a few things to make the fall session easy for our patrons...

Communication: Most of our communication in regard to classes and gym activities will be done via email. Please make sure we have at least one valid email on file for your family so that you can always be up to date on what's happening here at RPGA. Also, our "Important Dates" sheet has all the dates for make ups, parent's night out, gym closings, and everything you need to know for the semester. Please pick one up if you haven't already.

Make Up Days: Sometimes, it is necessary to miss class. We understand that schedules sometimes conflict and things come up, so this is expected. We offer two make up sessions for classes missed throughout the semester. Those dates are in November and December and can be found on our "Important Dates" sheet that is available in our office. All make ups must be scheduled through our office as well. As our session progresses, classes begin to fill making it difficult to offer make ups during our normal class schedules. Therefore, we cannot accommodate weekday make ups. We appreciate your understanding of this policy.

Class Day Changes: If, for any reason, you need to change your child's class date while a session is still in progress, you are allowed ONE class transfer during the session. This transfer will permanently change your child's class date and time as long as there is available space in the class you would like to switch to. We cannot guarantee a class switch for anyone, as it is all dependent on space availability. To inquire about a class switch, please contact our office.

Parking Lot Safety: As the days get shorter and the sun sets earlier in the evenings, please be mindful of children walking in the parking lot, especially during the transition times. We expect all children to be walking with a parent, but sometimes they are hard to see when backing out of a parking spot due to their small frames. We ask that everyone drive slowly and watch for our little ones, especially when the time changes later this fall.

Thank you for entrusting us with your wonderful children. We are excited to have them in class and look forward to watching them progress and grow in skill and confidence this session.
